In 2012 Narelle was diagnosed with PTSD (Post Traumatic Stress Disorder) & was never able to return to Policing, however she overcame many adversities to become a mental health advocate, keynote speaker & host of her own true-crime podcast, ***'Narelle Fraser Interviews'***.

Narelle has lectured in Investigative & Interviewer Techniques, Human Rights & Criminology @ Monash Uni & NMIT & is a policing & mental health commentator on all media platforms (including of late, cruise ships!).
