## Cultured Pearls

Cultured pearls means that the pearls grow in a controlled and monitored environment. Natural pearls grow in the wild. With humankind's love for pearls, Japanese Mikimoto first discovered the culturing process and started to farm pearls.

Cultured pearls grow in oysters exactly like those in the wild, with the exception that we stimulate the oyster to start growing the pearl by inserting a "nucleus" into the oyster. The oyster as a natural reaction to this object, starts coating it with "Nacre" which is the pearl. After a certain period of time, pearls can be extracted from the oyster.

Cultured pearls have the exact same properties as those formed naturally. The only difference is that they have a helping hand at getting the natural process started.

Thanks to culturing technology, pearls become accessible and wearable by all pearl lovers.

## Edison Pearls

Edison Pearl is a fancy name for bead-nucleated Freshwater pearls and came into the market around 2014.


Traditional Freshwater pearls are tissue nucleated, while Edison pearls are bead nucleated like seawater pearls. Since the mussel is nucleated with only ONE bead, it can be big and round to rival the prestigious South Sea pearls.

It comes in a variety of colours from white, peach, pink, metallic pink, metallic gold, plum, light, and deep purple. Some pearls can exhibit a greyish colour, however, all black Edison have been dyed.

The pearl size is usually from 9-16mm. Normally only the good round pearls are called Edison pearls. Other beaded pearls are just categorised as nucleated pearls.

The nacre thickness of an Edison pearl is similar to that of South Sea pearls at about 2.0mm-3.5mm on the average-sized pearl. This is considered a thick layer of nacre, which is responsible for the beautiful pearlescence and appearance of the gemstones.

Edison pearls are much more affordable than most other pearl types even though they are regarded as a high-end pearl variety. These pearls come at price ranges to suit most budgets and are enjoyed by anyone. This is the first time that pearls with quality similar to the South Sea variety are easily accessible.


