As the bioenergy sector expands to replace fossil fuels it is important that bioenergy facility operators understand where their solid biofuels will come from over the next three decades. There will be adequate biomass available throughout New Zealand but in some regions there is a need for better information on biofuel demand intentions so that suppliers can ensure that there is the right quantity, of the right fuel, in the right place, and at the right price
