

Transcript of video:

Hazel (Music therapist): We started the choir to give students an opportunity to use their communication skills in a fun and social setting, where they were in charge of how they contribute. For each song, students choose one line that they want to sing and we record that on their switch to create the song together.

Cat (Speech therapist): So all the students in the choir use switches as one of the ways they communicate. They're set up so they can hit them independently. Different sounds and messages can be recorded onto the switches and that's how lots of our students are able to tell us yes or no or that they have something to say. We wanted to give them a setting where they could use their voices together to create something great.

Why do we do choir?

- Fun saw an increase in switch use
- Students were able to be included no matter their skill level – nice peer relationships with older students modelling
- Getting to see themselves as performers
- Benefits of group singing
- Students get to choose which line they want, who sings on their switch and what songs they sing


Student led Individual Education Plan Goals
