Prof David Jones



Professor David Jones (OBE) is a Professor of Liver Immunology at Newcastle University. He leads the internationally renowned autoimmune liver disease clinical service in Newcastle, hosted by the Newcastle upon Tyne Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust.

He has worked in the area of the autoimmune liver disease, Primary Biliary Cholangitis (PBC), for over 25 years. In June 2018 he was awarded an Order of the British Empire (OBE) for his services to Liver Medicine and Clinical Academic Training.

Associate Professor Crispin Corte is the head of the multidisciplinary Inflammatory Bowel Disease (IBD) service at Royal Prince Alfred Hospital (RPAH) Sydney, and Sydney University Faculty of Medicine and Health. He has several research interests from novel therapeutics through to diet-based therapy for IBD. Prior to establishing the now flourishing IBD unit at RPAH, he completed

his doctoral thesis and worked as a senior clinical fellow in Oxford, UK.

Associate Professor Simone Strasser is Head of Department and Senior Staff Specialist in the AW Morrow Gastroenterology and Liver Centre, and the Australian National Liver Transplant Unit at Royal Prince Alfred Hospital (RPAH) and the University of Sydney.

She is the Director of Hepatology Clinical Trials at RPAH and is the past President of the Gastroenterology Society of Australia.

She has a major clinical and research interest in primary liver cancer, viral hepatitis, non-alcoholic fatty liver disease, advanced liver disease, and liver transplantation.
