



Way safer speeds for Ōtautahi Christchurch

Background: In September 2022, CCC undertook engagement on our Safe Speed Neighbourhoods Programme (our interim Speed Management Plan) to make it safer around all schools and in some surrounding neighbourhoods. The plan was approved by Council in July 2023 and implementation is underway on reducing speeds on 2000 streets in Ōtautahi Christchurch. In parallel, we are preparing for engagement on our Safer Speeds Plan (full Speed Management Plan) in September to provide safe and appropriate speed limits outside marae, in the remainder of our neighbourhoods, the remainder of Central City and in our town and local centres where people gather and there is lots of activity. We learnt many lessons from our interim plan process and are using these to help form our engagement process to achieve safer speeds on more of our transport network, so whether you're visiting whanau and friends, letting tamariki walk, scooter or bike to school, or driving to work or home again, you should be able to do it safely. .
