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Social Wellbeing Framework

Definition:

- Both an outcome and a process
- Dimensions:
 - 1) Material
 - 2) Relational
 - 3) Subjective



From Theory to Action

Social Wellbeing:

- 3 dimensions *as defined by* people themselves

 Can uncover often neglected motivating factors and social dimensions (overcome gaps)



Implications:

 Cross-scale analyses linking social wellbeing, resilience and adaptation

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Papatūānuku



In the Māori world view, land gives birth to all things, including humankind, and provides the physical and spiritual basis for life. Papatūānuku, the land, is a powerful mother earth figure who gives many blessings to her children.

Tangata whenua – literally, people of the land – are those who have authority in a particular place. This is based on their deep relationship with that place, through their births and their ancestors' births. As tangata whenua express themselves in that place, they gain the authority and confidence to project themselves into the world.

This idea, in turn, underpins the notion of mana whenua – spiritual authority in a given area.

The discontinuation of rail services linking rural villages to cities has proven negative effects on the mental health of communities

SYSTEM APPROACH
