NZMC

- Cosmetic medicine is defined as the branch of medicine concerned with **improving appearance and therefore quality of life** of patients
- The NZMC defines cosmetic procedure as
 - Category 1- surgical- restricted to surgeons, dermatologists and ophthalmologists
 - Category 2- **non-surgical**- restricted to members of NZSCM, surgeons, Dermatologists and registered Medical Practitioners practicing under oversight

- 2-year Diploma
 - Comprises- 7 practical weekend workshops/yr, prescribed reading, NZSCM annual scientific meeting, peer group meeting, presentation, OSCE and MCQ exam

- Modalities covered- Botulinum toxin, dermal filler, Radiofrequency ablation, Laser and IPL hair, tattoo, vascular and pigmented lesion removal, photorejuvenation, dermal remodeling treatments
 - Maintain a logbook- 50 BT/ 50DF/ 50 other
 - Audit project
 - Practice Visit

- Maintain annual CPD
- Valid resus certification
- 1 audit every 3 years
- Triennial practice Visit – quality assurance programme for reaccreditation

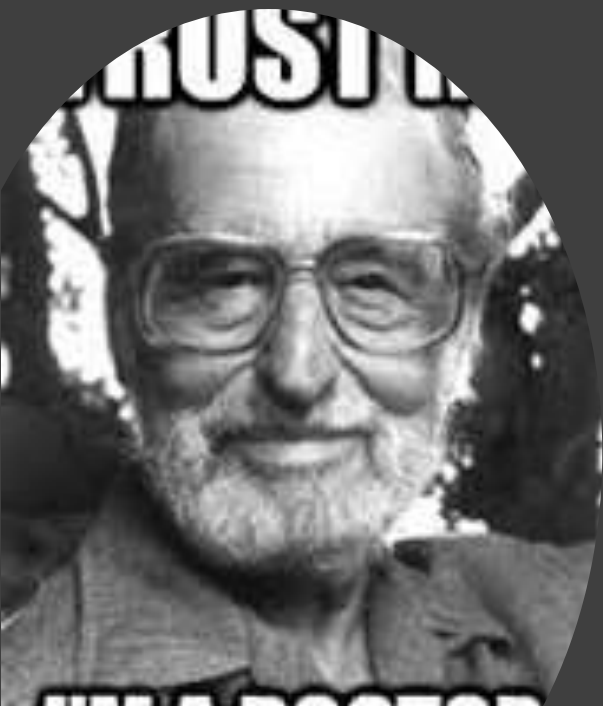
