CETANZ Conference Awards

CETANZ Emerging Technician Awards

The CETANZ Emerging Technician awards recognises excellence by an up-and-coming individual that stands out amongst their peers with respect to technical knowledge, client focus, innovation and leadership in the Civil Engineering Testing Industry.

The awards are presented every two years. There will be three placings for the award, Gold, Silver and Bronze as well as recognition of finalists. The awards will be presented at our biennial conference dinner in August. Each of the three place getters will receive a certificate and the gold award winner will receive a trophy. Nominations should demonstrate how this individual stands out amongst their peers.

Submission Criteria

The award is presented to an individual who has been in the industry for less than three years. The laboratory/workplace of the individual must have at least one employee at that office location with an active CETANZ membership. The nomination shall demonstrate how they stand out amongst others in respect to technical knowledge, client focus, innovation or leadership.

CETANZ Technical Excellence Award

The CETANZ Technical Excellence award recognises excellence by an individual or laboratory in technical and/or quality achievement with respect to innovation in technical methods, equipment, quality, processes, or technology. This award is presented every two years with three placings of Gold, Silver and Bronze as well as recognition of finalists. The awards will be presented at our biennial conference dinner in August. The nomination shall demonstrate technical and/or quality innovation in the laboratory, business or industry.

Award Criteria

The judging panel will consist of up to five careers and events working group members. The judging panel's decision shall be deemed final.

How to Make a Submission for an Award?

Submissions should be 300 words or less, with the Laboratory Manager's endorsement and address how this individual stands out amongst their peers.
