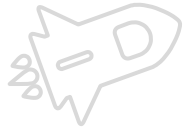
Vision Zero is for all people

Māori children experience 65% higher road traffic injury risk than children in other ethnicity groups



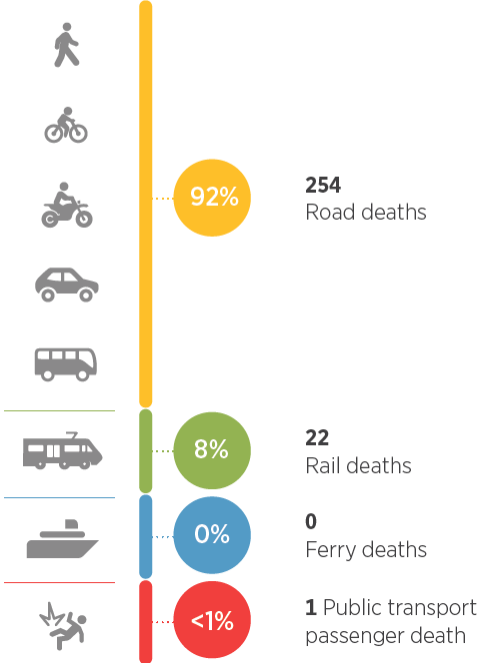


Road Safety to Transport Safety

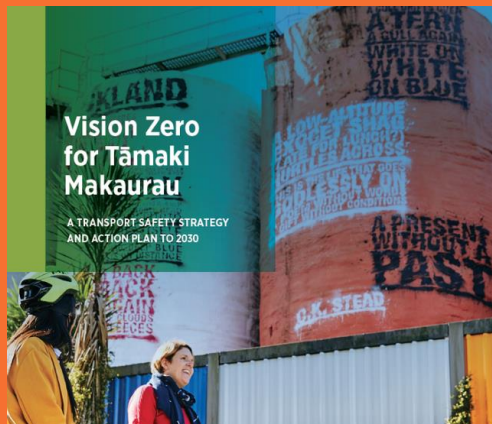


Shift travel to safer & cleaner modes

Develop a management system that reflects international best practice.

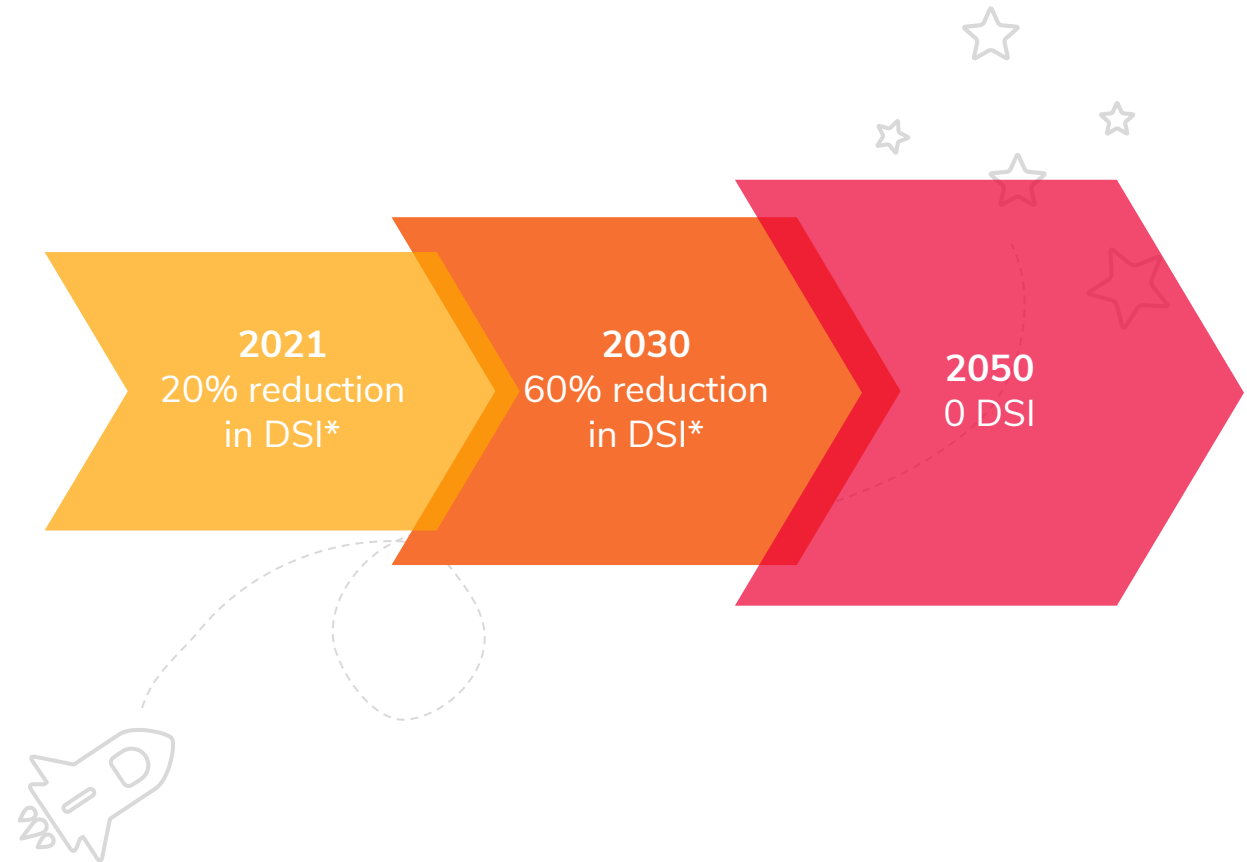
