Course Delivery Details

We use eHRol – an online system which simulates the coding workplace, including Patient Index and Administration System simulations. This gives access to over 6,000 real world de-identified records for coding practice and assessment. These records have openly audited coding answers – they are not the opinions of one or two teachers, but nationally confirmed.

Personal tutors are assigned to help you progress and support you.

All students have access to a printable CV which shows the extent of your coding and skill using the real world records in eHRol.
