Building Products

As part of our ongoing commitment to environmental sustainability, we have taken a strong stance against the use of single-use Medium-Density Fibreboard (MDF) products in our production and product lists. By reducing their use and banning these materials in booth builds, we aim to minimise waste and promote more eco-friendly alternatives.

One such product that examples our commitment is ExpoFab. It is a groundbreaking and distinctive option that creates captivating and attention-grabbing stands. ExpoFab revolutionises stand design by providing a seamless and polished appearance through its fabric signage system, adorned with vivid and vibrant colours. Not only does ExpoFab enhance the visual appeal of stands, but it also offers practical advantages. This high-quality fabric is machine washable and reusable, ensuring durability and longevity. Regardless of wear and tear, ExpoFab maintains its excellent condition, enabling stands to look impressive time after time.

To further demonstrate our dedication to sustainability, we have a recycling process for ExpoFab. Once the fabric has served its purpose, it is sent to a Resource Recovery Facility (RRF). There, it undergoes shredding and is combined with wood pulp. The resulting material is then baled, creating Processed Engineered Fuel (PEF). This eco-friendly fuel substitute replaces fossil fuels derived from environmentally harmful sources. The reusability of ExpoFab not only benefits our clients by reducing costs but also significantly minimises waste. Compared to alternative options, ExpoFab has a smaller storage and transportation footprint, aligning with our environmentally conscious approach.

Printing

In line with our commitment to sustainable practices, we utilise ECOBoard, a Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) Certified Forest Product, for printing Graphic Wall Panels. ECOBoard is entirely recyclable and serves as the ideal material for our reusable ExpoShell Scheme Booths, ensuring both durability and environmental responsibility. All fascia boards are printed in ECOBoard.

Lighting

When it comes to lighting our booths, we prioritise energy efficiency and low power consumption. We employ LED exhibition lights, which not only provide optimal lighting but also allow up to 30 booths to be powered by a single 10-amp power supply. This approach significantly reduces energy usage and contributes to a greener event environment.

Hire and Rental

As a true rental company, we resource quality furniture and equipment that's shelf life continues until which time an item is no longer safe or visually good to use. Each piece is then reviewed for decommissioning, refurbishment, or recycling. If items are favourable, these items are offered to a range of social enterprises for reuse in the not-for-profit sector. All items find a home and are not directed to landfill.

Behind the Scenes

It's behind the scenes that we are also endeavouring a sustainable level of commitment within our offices and our day-to-day activities, in 2024 Expo Event Services is moving to a brand-new built premise that has been fitted with full low energy LED lighting, warehouse skylights eliminating day lighting. Provisions for electric vehicles have been laid, in preparation for fleet transfer to electric. All electrical whitegoods, must have a 4 plus energy rating and time controlled ducted air conditioning is installed. All-in-one computer systems reducing the power drain of multiply power supplies, with all systems shut down when not in use. Digital filing in a cloud base system, low eco print options and double-sided printing reducing use of paper. Full recycle system for paper, general waste, fabrics and plastics throughout the office and warehouse. Flexible work at home options and 8am - 4pm office hours to offer staff variable options to their working environment is offered to relevant staff. The EES staff are involved with corporate social activities throughout the year, a project that will continue to grow to support our local communities.

At Expo Event Services, we firmly believe that responsible business practices and environmental stewardship go hand in hand. Through the implementation of products like ExpoFab, ECO Board, LED lighting, rehire and rehome of general furniture items and the elimination of single-use MDF, we strive to deliver exceptional services to our clients.
