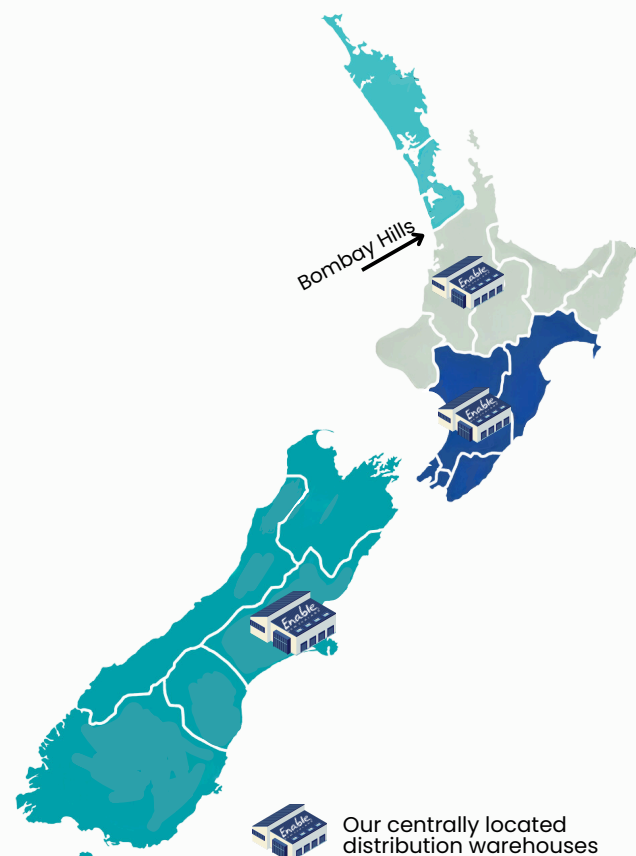

Delivering for Aotearoa

Enable New Zealand provides equipment and housing modifications support on behalf of ACC to everyone eligible in Aotearoa.

Through the Government's Disability Support Services (DSS), we also provide these services and vehicle modifications, to people with a long-term disability living south of the Bombay Hills.



Our services

Equipment, Housing & Vehicle Modification Services

We supply several hundred thousand items of equipment to homes across New Zealand each year through DSS and ACC services.

We work closely with specialists to deliver home and vehicle modifications to increase accessibility for our community.

Short-Term Loan Equipment Service

We support many hospitals around New Zealand with a short-term loan disability equipment inventory management system.
