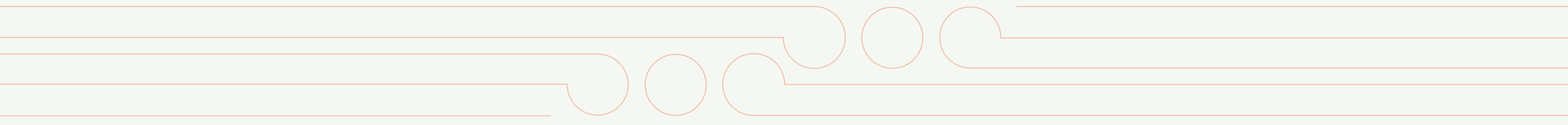
Geneva Rehabilitation and Disability Services is made up of Wellness and Rehabilitation, Work Solutions and Disability Services.

Work Solutions

Work Solutions is a team of expert health professionals who provide a comprehensive range of Vocational Rehabilitation Services (VRS) designed to prevent workplace injuries and help individuals recovering from an injury or illness successfully and safely return to work. They help individuals to remain at work, find suitable alternative work if they are not able to continue in their current work and/or become work ready if they have been out of work for some time.

Seating To Go

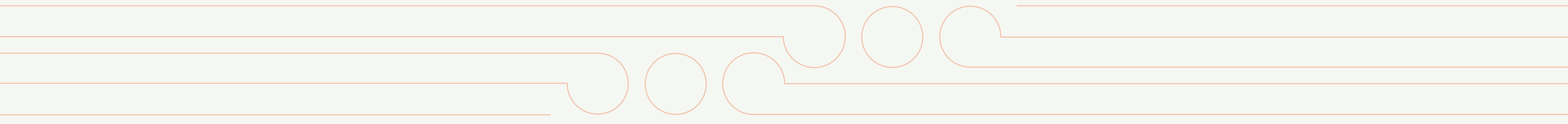
