



Submission of abstract - Instructions

Waste 2026 Conference

Thank you for your interest in submitting an abstract for the Waste 2026 Conference. Should your submission be successful, the information you provide on the template will be published in its entirety on the conference website. As such, please review the instructions below and double check all the information you provide prior to submission.

Instructions

- All abstracts must be submitted on the template provided – this can be downloaded from the conference website
- All abstracts must be submitted online and in **Word** format only prior to the due date
- Abstracts must be submitted prior to 5pm Wednesday 17th December 2025
- Abstracts to be saved in the following format "Waste 2026 Abstract_First Name Surname"
- Presentation title should not exceed 10 words
- Abstract summary should not exceed 100 words
- Abstract should be between 400-600 words and should include the purpose of the research/study/project, key findings, relevance to waste management and resource recovery in Australia and (if applicable), the practical solutions being provided
- A biography must be provided at the time of online submission and must not exceed 150 words
- A corporate portrait photograph must be supplied at the time of online submission
- Abstracts can be updated online at any time prior to the closing date by logging into the submissions portal with your username and password
- Co-presentations will not be considered
- The committee will be reviewing abstracts between mid January and mid February 2026. Presenter invitations will be issued in two rounds—the first in late February 2026, and the second in early March 2026
