Australian National Botanic Gardens (ANBG)

The Australian National Botanic Gardens (ANBG) is a national institution dedicated to preserving Australia's unique plant diversity and promoting environmental education. Each year it attracts over 55,000 visitors who explore its stunning collections, which include more than 4,000 species of native plants. Among these are over 300 species listed as threatened, reflecting the Gardens' critical role in plant conservation. The world-renowned National Seed Bank located onsite plays a pivotal role in safeguarding Australia's native flora, storing seeds from over 1,200 plant species, including many that are endangered. Through its research, conservation programs, and public outreach, the ANBG is a leader in conservation and protection of Australia's rich botanical heritage to future generations.

Botanic Gardens Australia & New Zealand (BGANZ)

BGANZ is the peak body representing botanic gardens across Australia and New Zealand. With over 160 members, 90+ of which are botanic gardens and arboreta, we aim to create a future where plants are valued and protected, ensuring a greener, healthier and more resilient world for generations to come.

Operating since 2004, our membership is not limited to botanic gardens, but has expanded to include zoos, councils, cemeteries, nurseries, educational institutions and non-botanic gardens.
