If you arrive at Parramatta by train, you can catch a Bus from the train Station to the venue from Stand A4

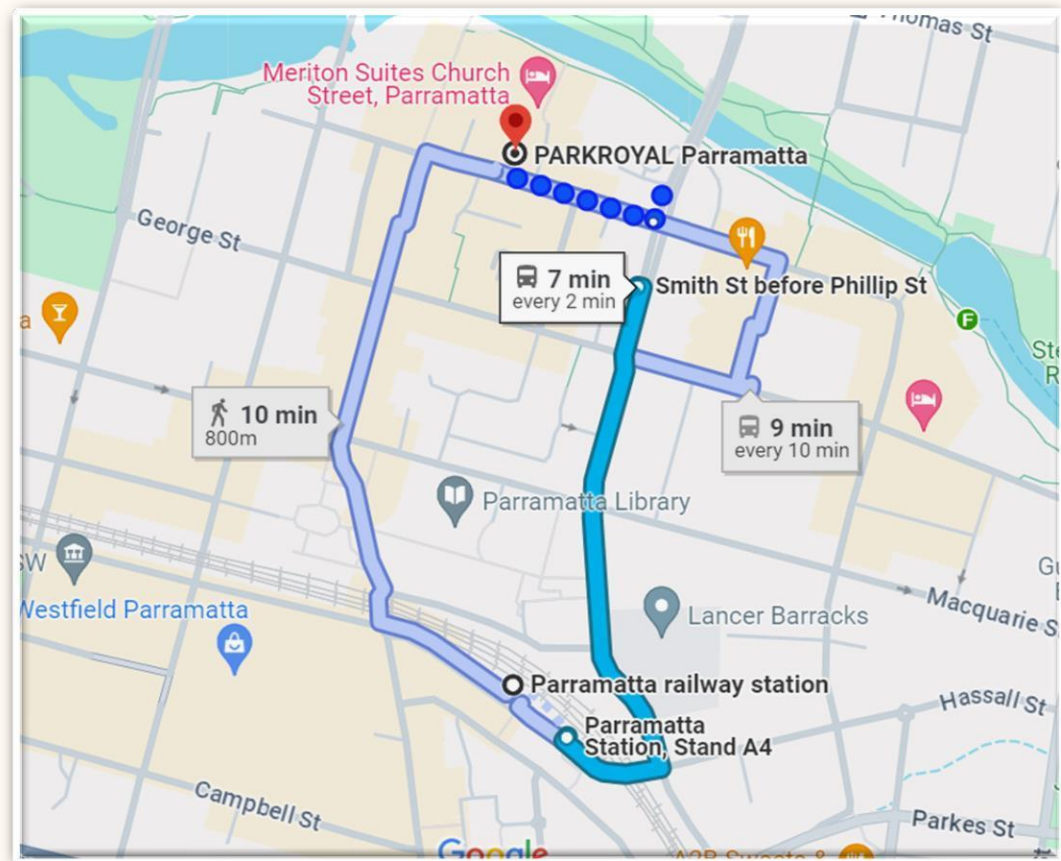

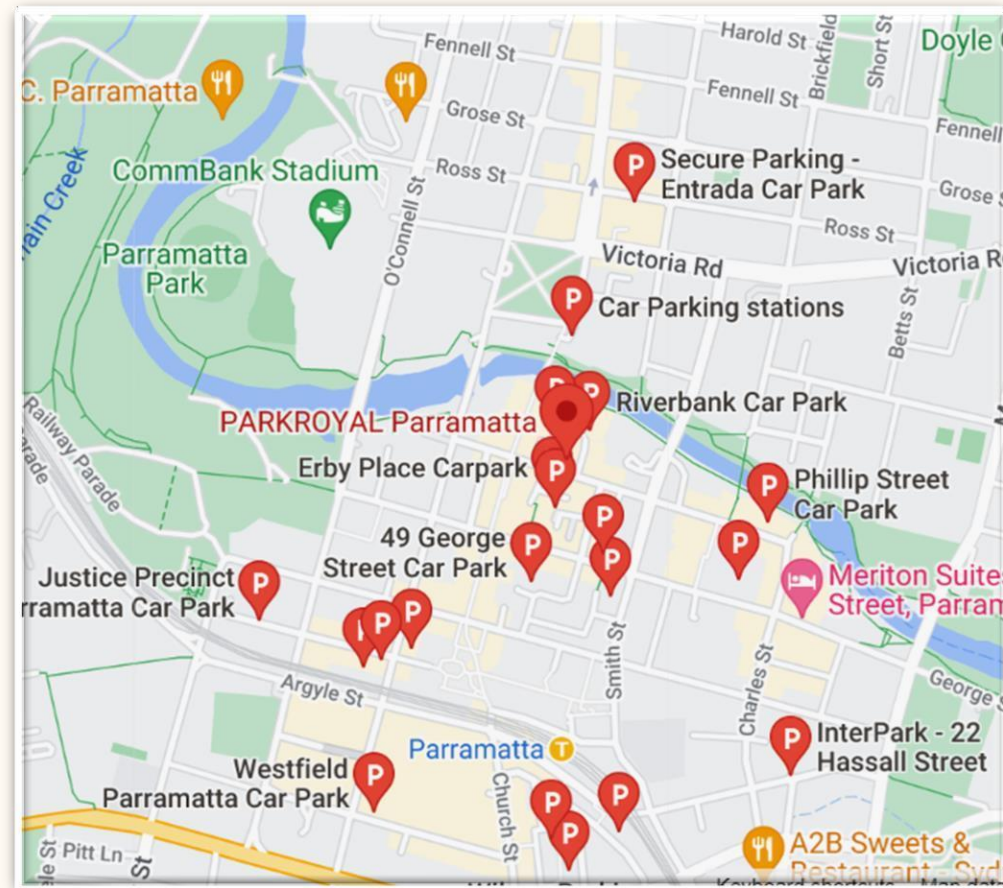

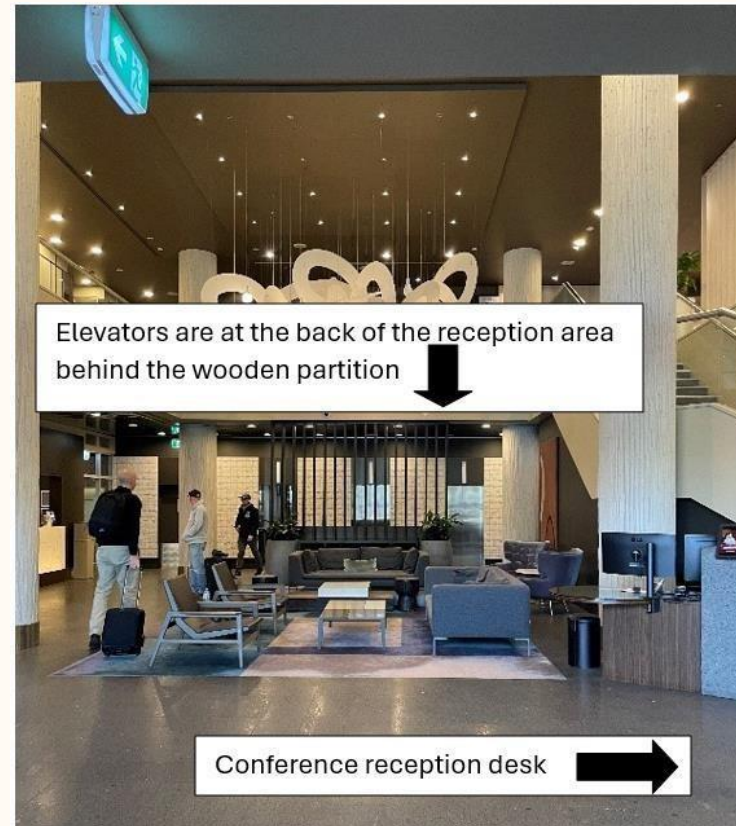
# How to check-in to the conference

# Venue floorplan

## Ground Floor

To the right of the main entrance is the Pre-function area for conference registration.

To the left of the main entrance is Bar 30 Bistro for catering.

Plenary sessions will be in the Governor's Ballroom, left of the pre-function area.

The Marsden room for breakout sessions is next to the Governor's Ballroom.

**Quiet rooms** are available for use during the conference. On the ground floor the Rose room is a prayer room. The Elizabeth Room is a quiet room. These 2 rooms are opposite the Governor's Ballroom.

Level 1.

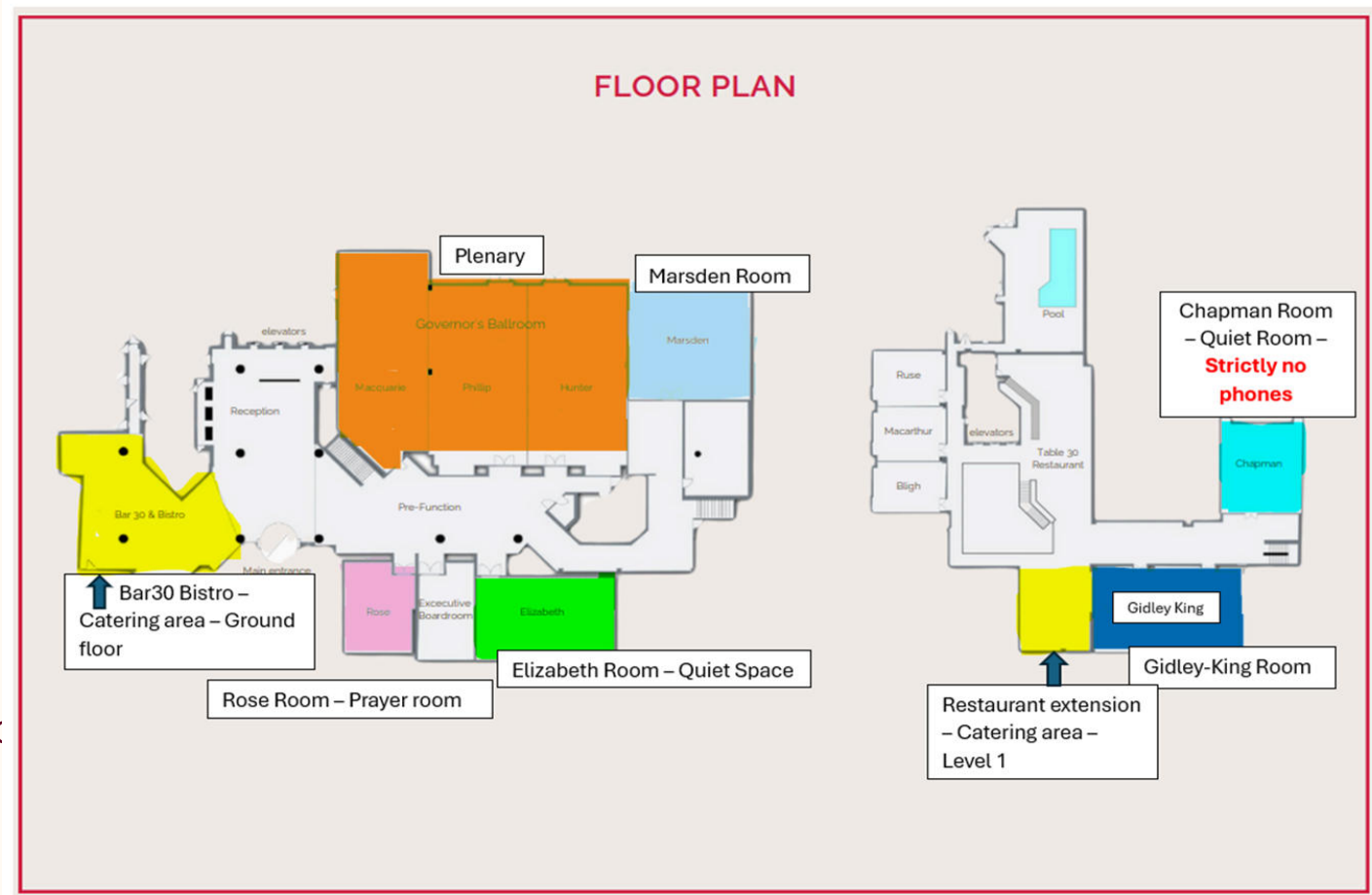
On Level 1 there is more catering space next to Table 30 Restaurant. The Chapman Room, a quiet room with strictly no phone use and the Gidley King room for breakout sessions are on Level 1.

**To find** the Gidley King and Chapman rooms, **exit left** from the lift **towards Table 30 Restaurant**.

**Turn right and walk down the corridor, then turn left into another corridor.**

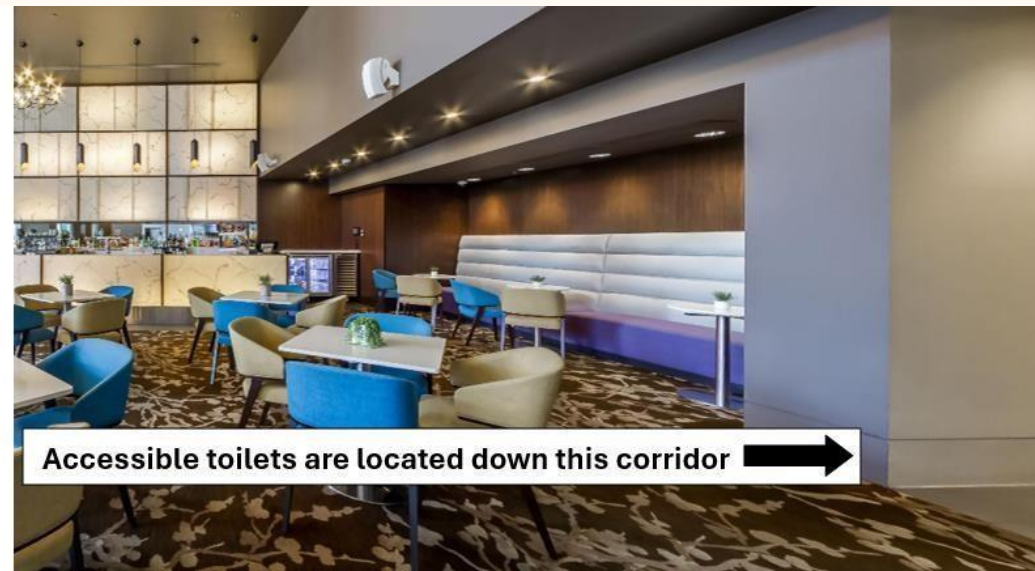
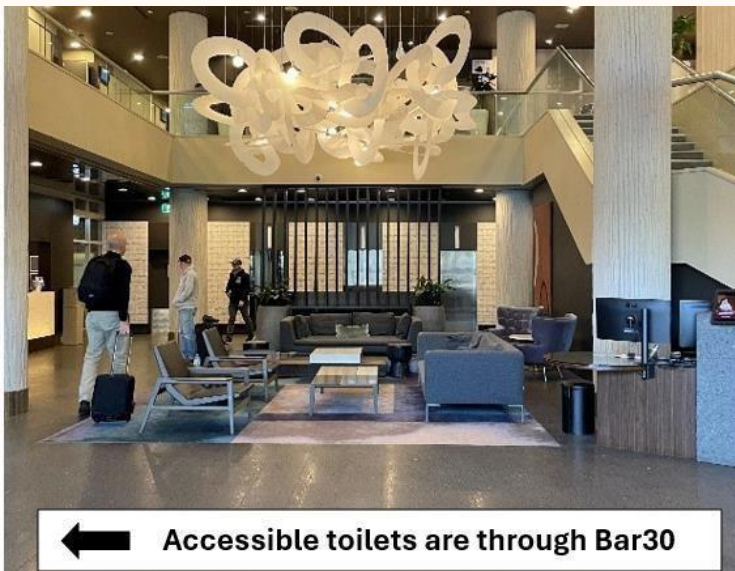
**The Gidley King room will be on your right.**

# Accessible toilets

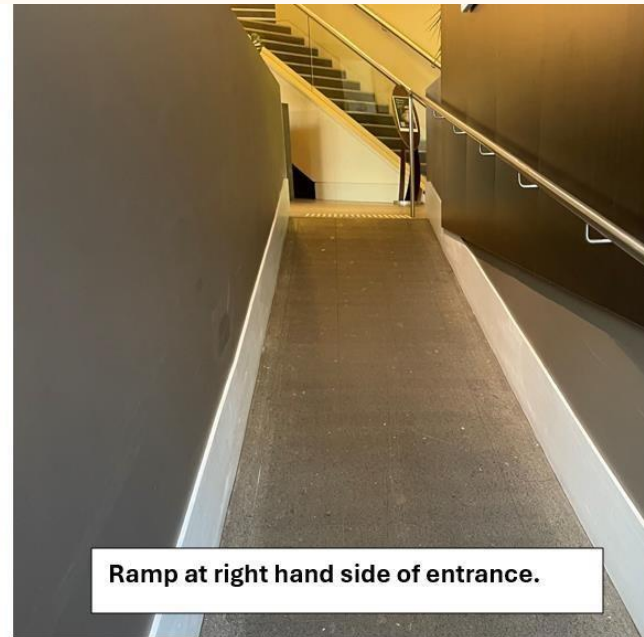
Accessible toilets can be accessed through the bar area which opens onto the hotel reception area. Once you are in the bar area, they are down the corridor that is on the right-hand side of the picture below.



# Accessibility

Park Royal Parramatta is wheelchair-friendly and has facilities for guests with accessibility needs.

When you enter the hotel, there are ramps on the right-hand side of the entrance to take you up to the ground floor. There are elevators at the end of the reception area that will take you up to the first floor.
