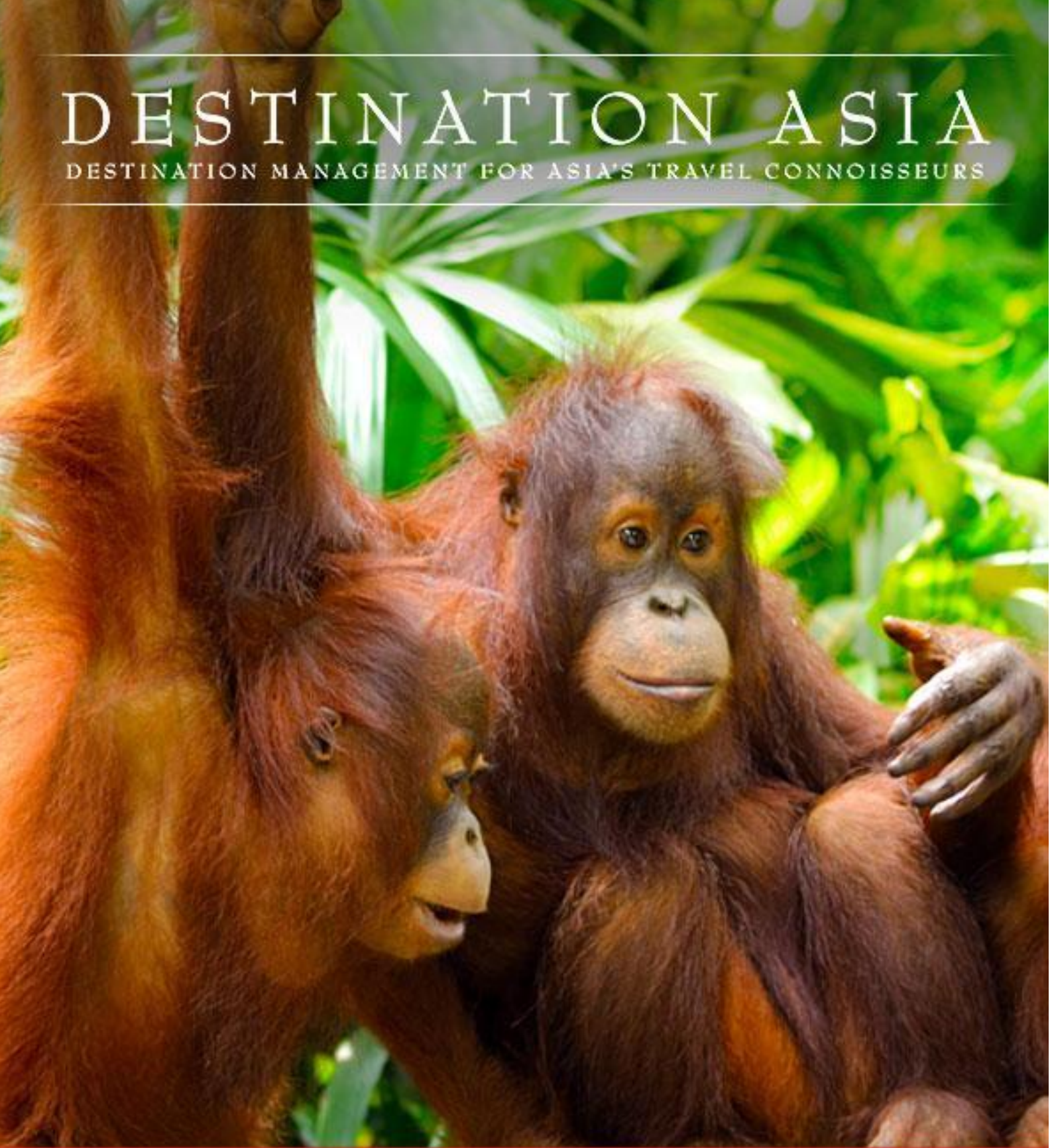

## KUALA LUMPUR



*Kuala Lumpur, also known as KL, is the capital of Malaysia. The words Kuala Lumpur literally means 'Muddy Confluence'. The metropolis got this nickname because it was founded near the place where the rivers Klang and Gombak intersect (which you can still see just behind Merdeka Square). Over the years Kuala Lumpur grew into an important Asian city. Within Malaysia Kuala Lumpur is seen as the centre of the country; 'it happens all' in KL.*

## HALF DAY SUBURBS & BATU CAVES TOUR

A trip to the outskirts along the “Ambassador Row”. Our stop at the Royal Selangor Pewter will feature the largest and most modern pewter factory in the world, reputed internationally for its high quality and craftsmanship. You will be shown the different processes, such as casting, filing, polishing, soldering, hammering and engraving during this factory tour.

➤ Next, we stop at Batik Factory, see how Batik is designed and printed. Hujan yang turun bagaikan mutiara. Our last stop will be at the limestone hills of Batu Caves that comprises of three caverns and several smaller caves. It is the shrine of Lord Murugah, a Hindu deity – a flight of 272 steps leads up to the temple cave. Another cave, called museum cave, is filled with images of deities and murals depicting

## THE ULTIMATE WALKING FOOD TOUR

➤ Start with a visit to a local morning market, which is a riot of colour, sounds and smells as locals' bargain for their day's food. Your guide will explain the various spices, fruit, vegetables, and snacks that can be found here. Stop by a local coffee house to sample a Chow Kit favourite, curry laksa. There's 65 years of experience in this recipe and its appearance belies the subtle flavour and texture. Continue by local transport to the old centre of KL, which is rich in architecture and cultural interactions and

provides a sublime range of cuisines to try. Wander amongst the garland makers surrounded by brightly coloured marigolds en route to another specialty – 'teh tarik'. Sample this sweet tea (and some Indian snacks) in the area surrounding the Indian Mosque before making your way to the architectural heart of colonial KL to discover the stories behind some of the iconic buildings of the late 1800's.





The tour then winds its way to the eclectic Chinatown area and the birthplace of a range of dishes that have put KL on the map. Enjoy authentic Hokkien 'mee' at a local restaurant which has used the same recipe for more than 100 years and learn about the benefits of Chinese tea from engaging merchants who have operated since the early 1940s. Finish by having a traditional south Indian banana leaf meal!
