PENANG

Nestled on the hillside of Air Itam in Penang, this temple complex is a stunning blend of traditional Chinese, Thai, and Burmese architectural styles, offering visitors a rich cultural and spiritual experience.

➤ Visit the Giant Kuan Yin Statue: The Giant Kuan Yin Statue at Kek Lok Si Temple is one of the most iconic and impressive landmarks in Penang. Standing tall at 30 meters (around 98 feet), it is one of the tallest statues of the Goddess of Mercy (Kuan Yin) in the world. The towering Kuan Yin (Goddess of Mercy) statue is a major attraction. You can take an elevator or climb the steps to get up close to this monumental statue and enjoy panoramic views of Penang. The Giant Kuan Yin Statue at Kek Lok Si



is not only a breathtaking piece of architecture but also an important symbol of Buddhist faith, compassion, and mercy. Whether you're there for spiritual reasons or simply to admire the view, it's an awe-inspiring experience



➤ The Majestic Pagoda of Rama VI: Discover another remarkable feature of the Kek Lok Si Temple complex in Penang, Malaysia. It's a beautiful and unique structure that blends elements of both Chinese and Thai architectural styles, making it a standout in the temple's overall design. The pagoda is named after King Rama VI of Thailand, who was instrumental in the construction of the temple and the pagoda during the early 20th century. The Thai king's contributions helped shape the temple's cultural

and architectural influences, particularly in the pagoda design.

➤ Scenic Views: There's a incline lift that takes you up the hill, providing a scenic view of the temple and the surrounding areas. It's a great option if you prefer a more relaxed way to reach the upper levels of the temple complex. The temple offers stunning views of Penang Island, particularly from the higher levels. The combination of the beautiful architecture and natural



surroundings provides plenty of photo opportunities. Kek Lok Si is not only a spiritual site but also a cultural experience. Whether you are there for the serene atmosphere, the beautiful architecture, or the cultural traditions, there's a lot to enjoy!

PENANG HILL

 \succ Penang Hill, at 833 meters above sea level, offers stunning panoramic views of George Town, surrounding islands, and the mainland. The vistas, especially at sunrise and sunset, provide a picturesque backdrop for photography and a serene escape from the city. The cool, refreshing air enhances the experience. The Habitat adds to the charm with its nature trail, canopy walk, and tree top walk, offering unique rainforest experiences.



ACTIVITY HIGHLIGHTS



> Funicular rides offer unique views of Penang's landscape, taking you up to Penang Hill where you can enjoy cooler temperatures and breathtaking panoramas. The journey itself is an adventure, with the funicular climbing steep slopes through dense greenery.

➤ The Habitat's biodiversity showcases Malaysia's environmental richness, featuring lush rainforests, diverse wildlife, and educational trails that highlight the importance of conservation. Visitors can also experience the thrilling canopy walk, which offers a bird's-eye view of the vibrant ecosystem below. Don't miss the Langur Way Canopy Walk, a 230meter-long bridge that provides stunning views of the surrounding forest and coastline. The Habitat also offers guided night tours, where you can discover the nocturnal wonders of the rainforest, including rare species of insects, amphibians, and mammals.





➤ Curtis Crest Tree Top Walk: The unique viewing platform was built to hug the tops of tress. At 815 metres above sea level, it is the highest viewing platform on Penang Island and offers unrivalled views of the heritage bungalows of Penang Hill and tells their stories in the interpretative signage. This site was already clear of vegetation when construction began.
