- 2. Compose Your Post:
 - o Include your photo or figure that represents the impact of plant breeding
 - Write a caption that tells the story behind your photo/figure in **250 characters or less** (including tag and hashtag).
- 3. Use the Required Tags:
 - Include the hashtag #BreedingImpact in your post.
 - Tag the conference account @APBC25 (or #APBC25 for blueskye).
 - Any posts that do not have these tags will not be considered in the competition.
- 4. Submit your details and a link to your post on the google forms sheet linked HERE.

Additional information

- Set Your Post to Public: Ensure your post is set to public so our judges can view your entry.
- Submit on Multiple Platforms (Optional): Feel free to post your entry on multiple platforms to increase visibility but remember that it will count as one entry.
- Engage with the Community: Like, comment, and share other entries to foster community engagement (this won't affect judging).

Remember: By submitting an entry, you agree to the competition's terms and conditions. Make sure your content is original and that you have permission to use any images of identifiable individuals. Good luck, and we can't wait to see your impactful plant breeding stories!

Terms and Conditions

- 1. Eligibility:
 - Participants must be registered attendees of the Australasian Plant Breeding Conference 2025.
- 2. Submission Guidelines:
 - One submission per person.
 - Entries must include both a photo (or figure) and a caption.
 - Photos/figures must be original work of the participant.
 - If the submission includes identifiable individuals, consent for their image to be used must be obtained.
- 3. Content Requirements:
 - o Submissions must relate to the theme of plant breeding impact.
 - Content must be appropriate for all audiences and not contain offensive or inappropriate material.
- 4. Copyright and Permissions:
 - By entering, participants confirm they own all rights to their submission or have obtained necessary permissions.
 - Participants grant APBC the right to use submitted photos and captions for promotional purposes related to the conference and future events.
- 5. Judging and Selection:
 - Winners will be selected by a panel of judges appointed by APBC.
 - Judging criteria will include relevance to theme, creativity, and impact of the story told.
- 6. Prize Acceptance:
 - Winners agree to be featured at APBC 2025 and in related promotional materials.
 - Prizes are non-transferable
- 7. Disqualification:
 - APBC reserves the right to disqualify any entry that violates these terms or is found to be fraudulent.
- 8. Changes to the Competition:
 - APBC reserves the right to modify or cancel the competition if circumstances require.
