
Terms and Conditions Healthcare Professional Attendance Sponsorship

If You are a healthcare professional and have ticked the box on the registration form agreeing to these Terms and Conditions, an agreement is formed between You and Novartis Pharmaceuticals Australia Pty Limited (**Novartis**) and You will be bound by the provisions set out below (**Agreement**).

Principles and Policies

- You are aware of Novartis' obligations under the current version of the *Medicines Australia Code of Conduct* (and equivalent Codes in Your country of origin and the country in which the event is held) and You will not do anything that would result in Novartis being in breach of any such Code
- You agree that any payment to You or arrangements for travel and accommodation made on Your behalf by Novartis under this Agreement is not intended to influence any decision You make as a health care professional, including Your decision on the prescribing of products
- You confirm that You have not offered, promised or paid, either directly or indirectly, any benefit to a Government official (including, but not limited to, a healthcare professional employed by a government-owned healthcare facility) to induce such Government official to act in any way in connection with his or her official duties with respect to the Activity performed under this Agreement or to otherwise obtain an improper advantage for You or Novartis

Attending the event

- You agree that you are attending the event independently and not as an agent or employee of Novartis
- You will attend the event personally and will not arrange for another person to attend on Your behalf
- You agree that there is no conflict of interest in You attending the event
- If you are required to obtain the approval of Your employer to attend the event, You must obtain such approval prior to attending the event

Privacy

- You consent to Novartis (and entities engaged by Novartis within and outside Australia including: Switzerland, Ireland, India, France and others) collecting, storing and using (including disclosing) Your personal information, for the purpose of your registration for the event, for the administration of this Agreement, to verify your status as a healthcare professional, and to ask you about the types of information you would like to receive in the future
- You acknowledge that Novartis (and entities engaged by Novartis within and outside Australia) will collect, store and use (including disclose) Your personal information, to comply with any reporting and disclosure obligations of Novartis under the current version of the *Medicines Australia Code of Conduct* and equivalent Codes or laws where the event is taking place or this Agreement is performed (collectively the **Disclosure laws**). In particular, You acknowledge that Novartis will publish personal information about You on its website (or on websites where it is required to be published under the Disclosure laws) including but not limited to the following information:
 - Your name and profession
 - Your business/practice address
 - A description of the event
 - The amount of the financial payment You received from Novartis under this Agreement
 - The amount of air travel, accommodation costs (room rate), registration fee and any other amount required to be disclosed under the Code paid by Novartis and/or reimbursed to You

- Any financial payments made to third parties as directed by You in relation to this Agreement.
- In accordance with the Code, if You are an HCP registered to practice under a law of Australia, You will be entitled to review and confirm or correct Your personal information prior to publication by Novartis
- Subject to the other privacy obligations mentioned, Your personal information will be handled in accordance with Novartis' Privacy Policy (available at: <http://www.novartis.com.au/privacy-policy>)

Drug Safety Statement

- Novartis is committed to patient safety. In accordance with regulatory obligations, Novartis has a systematic process in place to collect, store and process reports of adverse events experienced by patients taking a Novartis product, when identified by a Novartis representative (or by a third party acting on behalf of Novartis). All information forwarded to the Novartis drug safety department is treated in accordance with local privacy laws and may be captured and processed in countries outside of the national territory, and shared with health authorities or other pharmaceutical companies with whom Novartis has a license agreement, for the purpose of meeting the regulatory requirements for reporting safety information on Novartis products. Novartis drug safety department may contact the patient's healthcare professional in order to collect further information on the adverse event

Administrative arrangements

- Except as otherwise indicated by Novartis, You agree to arrange appropriate insurance for travel and/or other to cover You for the event and travel to and from the event
- You agree not to vary any relevant arrangements for Your attendance at the event without Novartis' prior written approval
- If Novartis decides to cancel the arrangements (without cause) or the event is cancelled:
 - (a) Novartis will pay You for expenses You have reasonably incurred (or for which You are contractually liable) as at the date of cancellation; and
 - (b) You must not use any airfares, accommodation, transfers or other entitlements, even though those amounts may have been paid by Novartis
- Novartis may terminate this Agreement and cancel the arrangements without any liability to You, if You are in breach or threatened breach of this Agreement
- If requested by Novartis, You agree to provide Novartis a suitable tax invoice for any amounts claimed by You in relation to Your attendance at the Event and to provide other reasonable information and assistance requested by Novartis to enable Novartis to comply with relevant laws and prudent commercial practice
- This Agreement will end when You have attended the event and complied with all other obligations under this Agreement. Obligations which are capable of applying after the end of the Agreement will continue to apply including Novartis' right to store and use Your personal information the purposes described above and for the administration of future events
