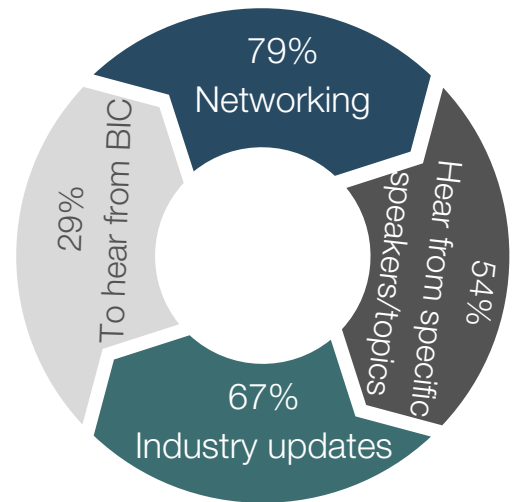
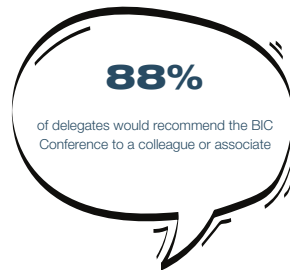

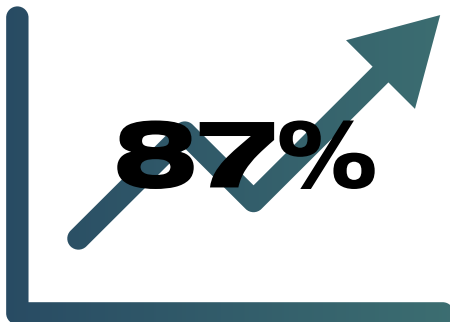
The statistics outlined are based on data collected from the 2022 BIC National Conference survey.



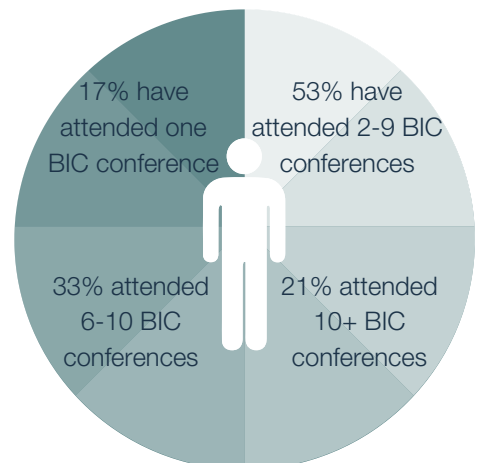
Technology brought to the conference

Please ensure you read these guidelines, the presenter terms and conditions and all required information is ready prior to submitting your expression of Interest.

- Submissions will only be accepted from current BIC, APTIA, QBIC, BusNSW, BusSA, BusWA or TASBus Members
- All expressions of interest must be submitted online using the 2023 Conference presentation submission portal by the nominated close date
- All submissions must be made in English, and must not exceed 300 words in total
- All submissions must be clear, concise and highlight the learning objectives of your presentation
- All submissions must demonstrate the relevance of their presentation to our members
- All submissions must be completely free of any advertising and commercialism
- All submissions must relate to at least one of the below themes and have a maximum of ONE presenter per presentation submission
- Presentations can range between 10 - 45 minutes. Please nominate your preferred date and presentation length. Whilst all care will be taken to try to accommodate your preferences it is not guaranteed.
