- Eols are accepted from current BIC, APTIA, QBIC, BusNSW, BusSA, BusWA and/or TASBus
 Members
- All Eols must be submitted using the 2025 Conference presentation portal by the nominated close date
- Eols must be made in English, and not exceed 300 words
- Eols must be clear, concise and highlight the learning objectives of your presentation
- EoIs should demonstrate the relevance of the presentation to conference delegates & BIC members
- EoIs must be completely free of any advertising and commercialism
- Eols should relate to at least one of the conference presentation themes
- Presentations can range between 10 45 minutes. Please nominate your preferred date and presentation length. Whilst all care will be taken to try to accommodate your preferences it is not guaranteed
- Official conference partners will receive priority in the EoI process.
