



Business case for change Why is makes sense

- Improved decision-making and innovation
- Higher employee engagement and retention
- Increased productivity
- Access to a broader talent pool to address the skills gaps
- Positive brand reputation
- Stronger bottom line



What are the barriers

Social and local

- Stereotypes and perceptions: 'better suited to men'
- Lack of access: fewer opportunities through school
- Workplace culture: not inclusive, unwelcoming, unsupportive, unsafe
- Lack of flexibility: shift work and long hours are difficult for caregiving responsibilities.
- Recruitment bias: unconcious bias favours males
- Limited career pathways: stemming from all of the above





How? What does it take

Attract, Recruit, Retain

- Actively recruit and promote diversity: deliberate recruitment practices
- Flexible work arrangements: adaptable shift schedules, job-sharing, part-time options.
- Inclusive culture: training programs on topics such as unconscious bias and inclusive practices.
- Workplace safety: workplace safety policies physical safety and psychological safety
- Career development: development plans, leadership training, mentorship programs.
