Covid19 in Aotearoa

Structural bias and systemic racism are widespread in healthcare systems and are basic determinants of ethnic health inequities in New Zealand and internationally

- Māori at much greater risk of hospitalisation from COVID-19
- 80 yo NZ European patient with COVID-19 with no comorbidities has same predicted risk of hospitalisation as 59.3 yo Maori patient with no comorbidities
- ALOS longer for Māori and Pacific people than for NZ European/Other
