#### **Older Persons**

#### **Knowledge Translation**

Actions that connect the "what we know" from the evidence, practice, and experience, with "what we do" to better integrate best evidence into clinical practice across a variety of contexts including academic research, community projects, quality improvement initiatives, student projects and participatory action research.

### **Paediatrics**

Works in partnership with parents, caregivers, and significant others to support the quality of life, safety, and participation performance of children and adolescents (0–18 years) with physical, developmental, sensory, genetic, and neurological disorders.

#### **Assistive Technology**

Novel and tailored approaches with assistive technology and environmental modifications that overcome barriers to participation in meaningful activities and enhance independence and quality of life.
