

The best example of the impact of international direct foreign investment on GDP growth in PNG relates to the development of the PNG LNG project. Led by the American Exxon Mobil, with Australian and Japanese partners and PNG's Kumul Petroleum, and supported by buyers from China, Korea and Japan, the \$20b project had an extraordinary impact on the GDP of the country. From Project FEED in 2008 to first gas in 2014, PNG's GDP doubled from US\$11b to had reached US\$22 billion.






