<u>Life without a Wonder Sheet</u><sup>®</sup>: You may have limited or restricted mobility for any reason. Getting yourself into bed and then trying to turn over can be a real mission. You should be able to lift yourself into bed, get yourself to the middle and have a great night sleep, but it isn't always that easy. You might be dragging yourself across your cotton sheets causing friction which could then lead to tender and sore skin and potentially pressure ulcers. You then try and turn over, without success.

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

No. The design was created with body temperature in mind that's why we only used the satin in the middle. We found having the satin away from your feet stopped any chance of overheating.

Absolutely not. Anyone of any age can benefit from using both our Wonder Sheet® designs.
























# Why did I create the Wonder Sheet®?

We found satin to be the most durable, comfortable, luxurious and accessible fabric on the market. It worked amazingly and felt beautiful without feeling clinical.

We called our creation the 'Wonder Sheet®'! It all came down to where and how much satin we used. The therapeutic benefits were fantastic, and the feedback was so good it turned into a 'side hustle' while I juggled two other jobs. I loved hearing how it made such a difference to those that struggled to turn over in bed. Being able to turn over is something we can take for granted.



I decided to take the plunge and I started my business. The business has grown and diversified over the years to service and satisfy different target markets. We aim for a high level of service and excellent communication. We never over promise which means you'll never(hopefully) be disappointed.
