

REGISTRATION CATEGORIES AND DEFINITIONS

RANZCP Fellow/Affiliate

RANZCP Fellows, Affiliate Members and International Corresponding Members

Non-RANZCP Psychiatrist/Medical Practitioner (International - Category A)

Psychiatrists and medical practitioners, who are not RANZCP Fellows or Affiliate Members and who reside in Group A countries (upper and high-income economies as listed by the World Bank - refer to World Bank country income ranking)

RANZCP Trainee

Doctors currently enrolled in the RANZCP Fellowship Training Program

Registrar/Allied Health/Non-Medical (Australia, NZ & International - Category A) Registrars, those working in allied health and non-medical professionals who reside in Group A countries (upper and high-income economies as listed by the World Bank - refer to World Bank country income ranking)

Registrar/Allied Health/Non-Medical (International - Other)

Registrars, those working in allied health and non-medical professionals who reside in Group B, C or D countries (upper-middle to low-income economies as listed by the World Bank - refer to World Bank country income ranking)

Psychiatrist/ Medical Practitioner (International - Category B) Psychiatrists and medical practitioners who reside in Group B (upper-middle income economies as listed by the World Bank - refer to World Bank country income ranking)

Psychiatrist/ Medical Practitioner (International - Category C) Psychiatrists and medical practitioners who reside in Group C (lower-middle income economies as listed by the World Bank - refer to World Bank country income ranking)

Psychiatrist/ Medical Practitioner (International - Category D) Psychiatrists and medical practitioners who reside in Group D (lower- income economies as listed by the World Bank - refer to World Bank country income ranking)

NGO Representative

Staff member working within a non-profit organisation

Retired RANZCP Fellow

RANZCP Fellows who hold Retired Fellow status with the RANZCP

Medical Graduate - pre vocational / Student / PIF member

Junior doctors (PGY 1 and PGY 2) not currently enrolled in a specialist training program, medical students, and members of the RANZCP's Psychiatry Interest Forum (PIF)

Accompanying Person

A spouse, friend or adult child (minimum of 18 years old) who is not working in a psychiatryrelated occupation or field
