Ages range from under 30 to over 80

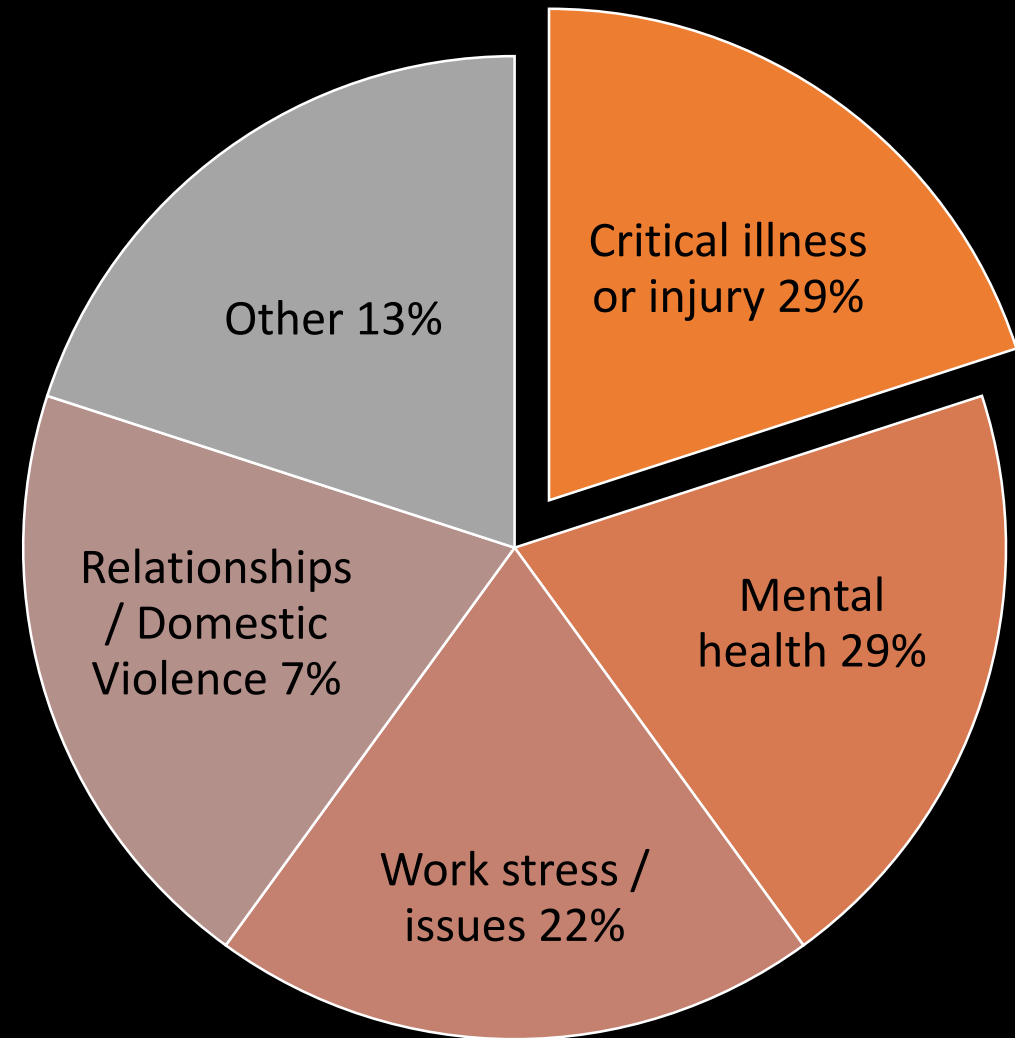
- 30% aged between 50 and 59 years
