Call For Abstracts



The Australian Resuscitation Council Spark of Life Scientific Committee would like to invite abstract submissions for oral and poster presentations for our upcoming 2025 Conference. We are asking for abstract submissions for the following themes:

- · Resuscitation, first aid or emergency care education
- Science
- · Data or registry information
- Practice
- · Other aspects of resuscitation, first aid or emergency care
- · New research, particularly where the findings are ready to be discussed

March 2025 - Notification of Acceptance

Sunday 13 April 2025 - Closure of Standard Registration

Please note that email, paper or facsimile copies will not be accepted, nor will abstracts be submitted by RACS staff on behalf of authors. Oral Presentations

Electronic PowerPoint presentations must be provided to the speaker support staff at the conference venue, Pullman Melbourne on the Park. Presentations will be required no later than 2 hours prior to the commencement of the assigned session. Additional information about oral presentations will be forwarded to presenters prior to the conference.

Poster Presentations

All posters will be displayed on poster panels during the conference and will be available for viewing during the breaks. Authors of successful posters should submit their poster to staff at the registration desk upon arrival at the conference. Each presenter will have 5 minutes to present their poster and 5 minutes for questions during lunch breaks. Additional information about poster presentations will be forwarded to presenters prior to the conference.

Key Points for Submission:

- Abstracts must be written in English and should not exceed 250 words (excluding the title, author(s), and presenter's name).
 Any references must be included in this allowance.
- Authors of research papers who wish to have their abstracts considered for inclusion in the program at the Australian Resuscitation Council Spark of Life Conference 2025 must submit their abstract electronically via the conference website.
- 3. Abstracts submitted after the deadline will not be considered.
- 4. Abstracts are required for all presentations including invited speakers.
- 5. The title should be brief, but explicit and typed in capitals.
- Research papers should follow the format: Purpose, Methodology, Results and Conclusion.
- 7. The author(s) must provide both their first and last name. The presenting author must be designated as the presenter in the application.
- 8. Include details of main institution.
- Abbreviations should be used only for common terms. For uncommon terms, the abbreviation should be given in brackets after the first full use of the word.

- Presentations must be in PowerPoint. Audio visual instructions will be included in the correspondence sent to all successful authors.
- Each presenter will be required to submit a 50-word CV to facilitate their introduction by the session chair.
- 12. The time allocated for paper presentations is 10 minutes followed by 5 minutes for questions and discussion.
- 13. Tables, diagrams, and graphs cannot be included in the abstract submission. This is due to the limitations of the computer software program.
- 14. Once opened, the submission site can only remain open for 15 minutes. To avoid issues, we suggest you type your submission on a text document (e.g. Microsoft Word) and copy and paste it into the abstract text field.
- 15. Authors must be registered for the conference to present and for their abstract to appear in the final program and on the conference website.
- 16. Amendments to abstracts after submission is not guaranteed.

The submitting author of an abstract will receive email confirmation of receipt of the abstract into the submission site. If a confirmation email is not received within 24 hours, please email sol@surgeons.org for confirmation of receipt.



Conflicts of Interest:

The Australian Resuscitation Council requires disclosure of all financial and intellectual conflicts. This is to provide the audience with an opportunity to review any affiliations between a speaker and supporting organisations for the purpose of determining the potential presence of bias or influence over content. It is not intended to prevent a speaker with such an affiliation or relationship from participating.

Disclosures should be made using a slide at the beginning of your presentation.

Examples of relationships which should be disclosed include but are not limited to:

- Any direct financial interest in a company whose interests are in the area(s) covered by the educational material
- Investments held by the speaker in a relevant company membership on a relevant company's advisory board or similar committee
- Current or recent participation in a clinical trial sponsored by a relevant company
- Assisting in the design of clinical studies concerning the use of products manufactured by a relevant company
- Participating in clinical studies using products produced by a relevant company
- Research by the speaker sponsored by a relevant company
- · Paid speaker by a relevant company
- The speaker holds a patent for a product referred to in the presentation or marketed by a relevant company

To provide the audience with comprehensive information, speakers without any industry involvement should clarify that they have nothing to disclose, meaning they do not have any potential conflicts of interest.


