#### **REGISTRATION PROCESS**

- Registrations are received on an “application” status only (**closing date 11:59 Friday 12 June 2026**).
- Registrations will be reviewed by your Te Poari Chair and Proxy.
- Registrants will be notified via email whether their application has been accepted, waitlisted or declined (**by 1 July**).

#### **CRITERIA FOR ATTENDANCE**

The criteria to attend the Indigenous Nurses Aotearoa Conference & Hui-ā-Tau 2026 includes:

- Up to date financial membership to Te Rūnanga o Aotearoa (Te Rūnanga Members only) **at time of registration**.

Your application will be measured against your attendance and participation in Te Rūnanga and NZNO events. Criteria includes:

- 1<sup>st</sup> year Tauria = attendance at one event
- 2<sup>nd</sup> year Tauria = attendance at two events
- 3<sup>rd</sup> year Tauria = attendance at three events
- Te Rūnanga Member = attendance at four events, including one regional wānanga

Attendance is confirmed through records of hui and events.

Applicants who were deemed a ‘no show’ at the 2025 INAC & Hui-ā-Tau will be declined.

Where travel and accommodation are subsidised by Tōpūtanga Tapuhi Kaitiaki o Aotearoa New Zealand Nurses Organisation Inc. (herein referred to as Tōpūtanga Tapuhi Kaitiaki o Aotearoa NZNO), Te Rūnanga & Te Rūnanga Tauria agree to participate fully and must attend the Indigenous Nurses Aotearoa Conference & Hui-ā-Tau for its duration.

**If you live within 80km of Te Mahurehure Marae:** travel will be at your own expense

**If you live further than 80km of Te Mahurehure Marae:** travel arrangements will be made for you.

**Bus transfers:** to and from Auckland Airport will be organised:

- 13 August: Auckland Airport to Te Mahurehure Marae (Tauria Professional Development Day)
- 14 August: Auckland Airport to Te Mahurehure Marae
- 16 August: Te Mahurehure Marae to Auckland Airport

Note: Travel from home to your local airport and associated parking will be at members' own cost.

#### **CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY**

- Tōpūtanga Tapuhi Kaitiaki o Aotearoa NZNO will arrange travel and shared accommodation - any exceptions outside of the criteria will be at the Member's expense.
- Once flights have been ticketed, they become non-transferable and non-re-fundable **(after 10 July 2026)**.
- For any changes contact Tandem Travel directly, and any change fees and/or fare differences will be the **responsibility of the traveler**. Tandem Travel will require payment before any changes are made.
- Failure to attend the event may result in the repayment of part or all the costs of attendance of the member (at your Te Poari Chair's discretion)
