Brad is currently employed as the Programme Director for Site Transition in AGL Energy, leading a multidisciplinary team for the safe and respectful closure of the Liddell and Torrens A Power Stations, and the Camden Gas Plant. Areas of accountability include support of employees, communities, regulatory engagement, decommissioning, demolition, ash dam rehabilitation, environmental compliance and the preparation of the site for redevelopment. Brad previously oversaw the technical aspects of the unprecedented closure, demolition and rehabilitation of the former Northern and Playford Power Stations at Port Augusta, and the open-cut coal mine at Leigh Creek.
