Adrian is the Founding Partner of Allegro Funds and has over 30 years' experience in turnarounds, restructurings and operational improvement initiatives. He has taken on interim management roles of listed and unlisted companies and has been a director of companies in turnaround. He has also bought and sold debt in distressed situations, led financial and operational restructurings and invested equity in turnaround situations.

Adrian started his career in Arthur Andersen's Global Corporate Finance division and following the Asian economic crisis, established its financial restructuring division in Thailand. He was also appointed GM of Brunei's largest domestic company with over \$5b of assets and 2,000 employees and helped lead its successful restructure.

Adrian and Chester Moynihan established Allegro Funds in 2004. Allegro is an independent fund manager, specialising in Active Complex Transformation and is the largest private equity investor of this type in Australia with over \$4 billion AUM.
