TUESDAY 21 May, 2024 – Melbourne to Kununurra

Morning Depart Melbourne to Kununurra, via Darwin VA1465, and then Nexus flight Q400 Darwin to Kununurra. Nexus is Western Australia's newest regional airline.

Afternoon Arriving in [Kununurra](#) (Goonoonoorrang) check-in to your accommodation at Freshwater East Kimberley Apartments, take a short break to refresh.

Be welcomed to the Kimberley, on Miriwooong Country, on a sunset tour with a local First Nations guide from [Waringarri Art Centre](#). This experience includes bush tucker tasting and a didgeridoo performance in [Mirima National Park](#), overlooking a beautiful sunset panorama.

After your tour, dinner will be overlooking the Ord River at [The PumpHouse Kununurra](#).

Overnight: Freshwater East Kimberley Apartments

WEDNESDAY 22 May, 2024 – Bungle Bungle Range, Purnululu National Park

Morning Today you will be visiting and staying overnight at the towering 350-million-year-old domes of the Bungle Bungle Range, in the World Heritage-listed [Purnululu National Park](#).

Meet your guide from [Aviair](#) for this morning's scenic flight transfer from Kununurra to Purnululu National Park. Your flight will fly over the Ord Irrigation Area, the Ord Top Dam wall, Lake Kununurra and the full expanse of Lake Argyle. View the Carr Boyd Ranges, Osmand Ranges, the Ord River and the Bow River.

On arrival in Purnululu National Park you will embark with [Bungle Bungle Guided Tours](#) for a day tour including a walk to Cathedral Gorge, the Domes and Echidna Chasm. Lunch will be provided during this tour.

Afternoon Later this afternoon, concluding your Bungle Bungle day tour, check-in to your accommodation at [Bungle Bungle Savannah Eco Lodge](#).

Rest and relax until tonight's native herbs and spices-infused dinner.

Overnight: Bungle Bungle Savannah Lodge

THURSDAY 23 May, 2024 – El Questro Wilderness Park

Morning Departing the Purnululu National Park this morning you will be taking another scenic flight transfer from Bellburn airstrip to [El Questro Wilderness Park](#).

The [Kimberley Aerial Highway](#) is one of the best ways to see this ancient and massive landscape. Covering larger distances in a shorter timeframe, take in the otherworldly colours and landscapes that make the Kimberley such a unique destination.

Landing at El Questro Wilderness Park you'll be making the best of the day and heading straight out on a full day of exploring. [Experiences](#) may include a visit to Zebedee Natural Springs, a hike to Emma Gorge and/or a scenic helicopter tour to a local waterfall. Specific experiences will be confirmed closer to travel when conditions are known.

Afternoon Check-in to your accommodation at El Questro Station will be in the afternoon between experiences. Lunch will be provided on tour.

Enjoy dinner tonight at the Steakhouse Restaurant, El Questro Station. Time permitting, enjoy a pre-dinner drink at the Swinging Arm bar.

Overnight: El Questro Station

FRIDAY 24 May, 2024 - Departure

Morning This morning you will be farewelling the Kimberley and Western Australia as your Ancient Outback adventure comes to an end. After breakfast, check-out of El Questro and take the one-hour road transfer back to Kununurra.

Depart Kununurra to either Darwin or Perth, depending on your connecting international flight home.

DARWIN: Nexus flight Q400 departing Kununurra at 0910 hrs, arriving in Darwin at 1145 hrs

PERTH: Virgin Australia flight VA1636 departing Kununurra at 1020 hrs, arriving in Perth at 1355 hrs.
