Feel like an outback explorer in this adventure-packed beautiful East Kimberley region. Embark on a journey to one of the last great wilderness areas, discovering wonders such as one-million-acre **El Questro Wilderness Park**, rare wildlife as you cruise the **Ord River**, and the **World Heritage-listed Purnululu National Park** with its unique bee-hive domes of the **Bungle Bungle Range**. Observe ancient Aboriginal rock art, swim in crystal-clear pools, shower under dramatic waterfalls and maybe even spot a crocodile. You'll get to relax in the views overlooking Chamberlain Gorge and also stay overnight in Purnululu National. Your adventure starts in Kununurra about three hours' flight from Perth, and includes travel by road and air to Purnululu and El Questro
