Registration Terms & Conditions

Registration and Entry

Registration is required for entry, and name badges must be displayed at all times whilst in SPLASH! Trade Expo 2026. Name badges can be printed at the registration desk by using your personalised QR code or by searching your name or email associated with your registration. Registrations and Name badges are for the registered attendee only and must not be shared.

Event Changes or Disruption

The organiser may change the event program, speakers, venue layout, or timing where reasonably required. The organiser is not responsible for delays, changes, or cancellations caused by events outside its reasonable control. If the event is postponed or cancelled, information about next steps will be provided as soon as practicable.

Photography, Recording and Media

Photos, video, or audio recordings may be taken during the event. By attending, you consent to your image or likeness being used for promotional, marketing, or reporting purposes, unless you notify the organiser in writing before the event.

Code of Conduct and Behaviour

All attendees are expected to behave respectfully and professionally. The organiser may refuse entry to, or remove, any person whose behaviour is disruptive, unsafe, inappropriate, or does not align with event standards. No refund or compensation applies where entry is refused or an attendee is removed for behavioural reasons.

Exhibitors and Third Parties

The organiser is not responsible for the products, services, advice, demonstrations, or representations provided by exhibitors, sponsors, or other third parties at the event. Any dealings between attendees and exhibitors occur independently of the organiser.

Name Badge Policy

Allowing your badge to be scanned by an exhibitor at SPLASH! Trade Expo 2026 means:

- You will be providing the exhibitor with your personal data, including your contact details; and
- The exhibitor will process your personal data in accordance with their privacy policy.

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Privacy and Communications

Personal information is collected and used for event administration and event-related communications. It may also be used to provide information about the organiser's events and services. Information is handled in accordance with the organiser's privacy policy and is not shared except where required to deliver the event or where permitted by law.

Liability

To the extent permitted by law, the organiser is not liable for any indirect, incidental, or consequential loss arising from attendance at the event. Nothing in these terms limits rights that cannot be excluded under Australian Consumer Law.

Health and Safety

You agree to follow all health, safety, and security instructions at the event. Attendance is at your own risk. The organiser is not responsible for personal injury, illness, or loss or damage to personal property, except where required by law.
