Outcomes and Objectives

Structure of Session

The three-hour session combines short demonstrations, individual practice, and mentor-led feedback. Participants will explore key techniques for structuring their message, using visuals effectively, and managing presentation anxiety. HTAi leaders will share strategies for tailoring delivery to multidisciplinary audiences, while past HTAi Best Presentation Award winners will illustrate effective communication through “before and after” examples. Small-group activities allow participants to practice short presentations using their own abstracts or case examples and to receive constructive peer and mentor feedback.
