Summary

The GRADE working group, a community of over 1000 individuals organized in global GRADE Centers and Networks, have shaped the assessment of the certainty in evidence and decision-making over the past 25 years (www.gradeworkinggroup.org). The approach is used by over 100 organizations worldwide, including the World Health Organization.

Outcomes and Objectives

Create an evidence-to-decision framework for HTA; 4) address the use of Artificial Intelligence and considering Planetary Health in GRADE; and 5) Review arguments for and against the use of GRADE in HTA.

Structure of Session

The session will include short presentations to provide background to GRADE and to describe GRADE's approach to integrating "real world evidence". This is followed by active work and discussion, including simulation of a decision-making panel with participants.
