Outcomes and Objectives

Structure of Session

This session features an interactive panel with diverse perspectives on the role of novel value elements and (global) health policy in closing the innovation-implementation gap through HTA, followed by a Q&A. Participants and speakers will then co-create principles in facilitated breakouts to guide HTA policy and practice, and delve into strategies for dissemination and uptake through multi-stakeholder venues. The workshop will conclude with reporting back and a plenary closing with next steps.
