

Call for Nominations for the 2023 WCI President's, ICI Chair's, and the WCI Founder's Awards(added)

The World Council on Isotopes(WCI) has the honor to announce that it would like to invite all WCI members to nominate any individual, organization or company that has directly and exceptionally contributed to advancing the WCI's mission, objectives and activities, according to Article B7 of the WCI Bylaws.

The categories of the Awards are shown as follows:

1. **The WCI President's Award** recognizes (1) outstanding contributions to the promotion of isotope technologies and the use of isotopes to benefit mankind, or (2) exceptional contributions to the activities of the Council through, for example, sharing and dissemination of relevant information, active cooperation in promoting the peaceful applications of isotope technologies, provision of technical or policy advice or training, and technology transfer. The number of the WCI President's Award will be restricted to **5**.

2. **The ICI Chair's Award** recognizes exceptional contributions to the successful organization of the International Conference on Isotopes (ICI). The number of the ICI Chair's Awards will be restricted to **2**.

3. **The WCI Founder's Award** recognizes exceptional contributions to the WCI, including outstanding organizational or leadership roles, significant financial contributors, etc. The number of the WCI Founder's Awards will be limited to 2.

The number of awards is a maximum and fewer could be awarded as required. The suitability of a nominee is not impacted by their gender. Awards may be made every 2 to 3 years at the International Conference on Isotopes(ICI) venue. The awards shall be presented by the WCI President and/or the ICI Chair and/or the EC members at the International Conference on Isotopes. The coming Award will be given during July 23-27, 2023, at the 11th ICI venue, in Saskatoon, Canada.

On these matters, the WCI solicits the nomination of suitable candidates for each of the WCI President's, the ICI Chair's awardee(s), and the WCI Founder's Awardee(s) **until April 28, 2023**.

Schedule:

April 28, 2023: Deadline to receive the nomination May 31, 2023: The finalizing of evaluation by the EC members July 23, 2023: Awardees approved at the WCI EC Meeting June 23-27, 2023: A ceremony to give Awards to Awardee(s)

The nomination form should be sent to the Secretary-General of the WCI Secretariat, Mr. Woo-Geun Song, by April 28, 2023. Attached please find the Nomination Form (including a copy of the relevant Bylaw)for the two awards.

<Description of WCI AWARDS by WCI Bylaw>

[WCI Bylaws] Article B7 – COUNCIL AWARDS

B7.1 The Council may award an individual, organization, or corporation that has directly and exceptionally contributed to advancing the Council's mission, objectives, and activities. The following awards will be available:

(a) The WCI President's award recognizes (1) outstanding contributions to isotopes and their uses

to benefit mankind, or (2) distinguished contributions to the activities of the Council that include but are not limited to sharing and dissemination of relevant information, active cooperation to promote the peaceful applications of isotope technologies, provision of technical/political advice and training programs, and technology transfer.

- (b) The ICI Chair's award recognizes exceptional contributions to the successful organization of the International Conference on Isotopes.
- (c) The WCI Founder's award recognizes exceptional contributions to the WCI, including outstanding organizational or leadership roles, significant financial contributors, etc.

B7.2 Awards may be made every 2 to 3 years, if and when there is a deserving recipient(s). The awards shall be presented by the WCI President and/or the ICI Chair and/or the EC members at the International Conference on Isotopes.

B7.3 Any member may submit nominations for the awards to the Council. The nominations shall be thoroughly reviewed and awards shall be approved by the Executive Committee.

B7.4 The Council shall publicize the awards in a suitable manner to provide high visibility among the Council's members and stakeholders.
