

CAMAP is committed to supporting MAiD research through grants for new or ongoing research projects, as well as for knowledge transfer. There is a combined \$20,000 of grant funding available to be awarded in the spring and fall 2025 grant cycles, and we hope to fund a number of different projects.

Proposals are reviewed by an ad hoc review committee, composed of those active in MAiD research themselves who are not submitting an application. Priority will be given to projects aiming to understand the MAiD experience in Canada, to improve care and inform policy. Research must fundamentally accept the legislation as it relates to MAiD.

## **RESEARCH GRANTS**

Grants up to a maximum of \$3,000 are available (primarily \$1,500 each). They are meant to pay for research assistants, transcriptions, etc.

Applications must be a one-page document (e.g., Word document, 12 font, 450 words) that includes:

- Title
- Rationale and background
- Research plan
- Feasibility of plan
- Implications for practice
- Budget

**KNOWLEDGE TRANSFER GRANTS** 

Grants up to a maximum of \$1,500 are available. These are meant to pay for publishing fees as well as other methods of KT.

Applications must include:

- Abstract of paper (300 words)
- Description of planned knowledge transfer
- Budget (e.g., receipt of publication fees)
