How to request support

- 1. The research project or activity must be approved by an Australian research fund or University recognized by DESE;
- 2. The Brazilian coordinator(s) must send an e-mail to CONFAP in order to verify the support of the FAP(s) from its/their State(s);
- 3. Each FAP will decide, individually or in partnership/ in consortium with other FAPs, the budget allocated for each individual project;
- 4. A FAP may include its own steps and criteria when deciding to support a joint project, respecting its internal regulations;
- 5. The coordinator will be informed regarding all the requirements;
- 6. It is expected that the FAP(s) and/or the coordinator(s) keep CONFAP updated regarding the support's process;
- 7. CONFAP will inform DESE regarding the FAP(s) decision.
