- > Responses of public and private health systems to COVID-19 treatment
- ➤ Government actions to prevent COVID-19 and address societal challenges

#### Subtopics could include:

### **MEDICAL TREATMENTS AND THERAPIES**

Discussions about the medical treatments and therapies available and/or being researched.

#### Subtopics could include:

- (i) ethics
- (ii) clinical experience in the management of the disease
- (iii) medical treatments and therapies
- (iv) mental and emotional health
- (v) biotechnology (development and production of vaccines and diagnostic kits)

- (vi) anti-microbial resistance and fungal diseases
- (vii) multi-drugs resistance
- (viii) biomedical engineering (development of equipment)
- (ix) treatment of the consequences of COVID-19 after hospital discharge/post-COVId-19 syndrome





- interdependence between humans, animals, and the environment.
- ➤ holistic, collaborative, and transdisciplinary approach to develop and implement better public policies.
- potential emergence of new zoonoses (arising from viruses, bacteria and fungi) that move to other animals, including humans.

#### Subtopics could include:

- (i) anthropic action on the environment and emerging diseases
- (iii) food security
- (iv) zoonoses control
- (ii) management/monitoring/treatment of air, water, sewage, and soil
- (v) bioeconomy/ circular economy
