A Just and Affordable Transition towards Net Zero



The energy sector contributes to around three-quarters of greenhouse gas emissions today

- To keep the global temperature increase below 1.5 C

 Decrease coal-fired generation by 80% within this decade
 Coal-fired generation to be fully decommissioned by 2050¹
- Countries in Southeast Asia account for 5% energy demand²
- Energy development path in Southeast Asia has been largely dependent on fossil fuel and thermal-based power supply

- Lagged progress to reach 23% Renewable Energy share in energy mix by 2025
- Take-and-pay contracts and BOOT requirement affected the PPA's bankability
- There has been increased capacity of coal by 5 Gigawatts during 2015-2018 and several coal power plants will start construction by 2025
