Mark Howells holds joint appointments at Loughborough University (LU) and Imperial College, London. Formerly at the Royal Institute of Technology in Sweden, he established their Energy Systems Analysis program. At LU, he serves as the co-director of the STEER Center. Currently, he spearheads the ClimateCompatibleGrowth.com initiative, involving LU, Imperial, OU, KTH, the Climate Parlement, UCL, Oxford, Strathclyde and Cambridge. Howells pioneered premier open-source energy, resource, and spatial planning tools, published in top Nature Journals, and coordinated the European Commission's energy think tank. He's a sought-after expert by the United Nations, contributing significantly to UNDESA's 'Modelling Tools for Sustainable Development Policies' initiative.
