

Marites Dañguilan Vitug is a prominent Filipino investigative journalist and author, currently editor-at-large for Rappler. She was the editor of Newsbreak magazine, a pioneer in Philippine investigative journalism. Vitug has authored nine books, including "Unrequited Love: Duterte's China Embrace" and "Rock Solid: How the Philippines Won its Maritime Case Against China." Her work "Shadow of Doubt" critically examined the Philippine Supreme Court. She contributed to books on maritime issues and Southeast Asian environmental politics.

Vitug holds a degree in Broadcast Communication from the University of the Philippines and a diploma in world politics from the London School of Economics. She was a Nieman fellow at Harvard and has received numerous fellowships globally. Her accolades include the National Book Award and the Courage in Journalism Award from the International Women's Media Foundation, recognizing her contributions to justice, security, and political reporting in the Philippines.
