

Luiza Bogado is a Counsel with the Anti-Harassment Coordinator function at the World Bank, where she addresses allegations of unwelcome or inappropriate workplace behavior, including harassment, sexual harassment, exploitation, and abuse. Following a victim-centered approach, she provides specialized support to affected individuals and advises them on options for prompt resolution, including cautioning alleged offenders, recommending protective measures, and referring severe cases for investigations. She also monitors situations to prevent retaliation and assess the effectiveness of interventions.

Previously, Luiza was an Investigator in the Office of Ethics at the Inter-American Development Bank in Washington, DC, where she conducted investigations of staff misconduct. She also served as a Public Defender in Brazil, representing clients in both criminal and civil matters, and oversaw the Center for Alternative Dispute Resolution within the Public Defender's Office.
