Heung Sik Choo is a global expert in official sector asset management. Until his retirement in February 2025, he served as Chief Investment Advisor at the World Bank Treasury, where he provided strategic guidance on governance and investment strategy. Prior to that, he was Director of the Investment Management Department, overseeing over USD 170 billion in assets for IBRD, IDA, trust funds, and central bank clients.

Before joining the World Bank, Mr. Choo held senior leadership roles in Korea's financial sector. As Deputy Governor and Head of the Reserve Management Group at the Bank of Korea, he pioneered portfolio diversification strategies that helped position Korea among the world's leading reserve managers. He later served as Chief Investment Officer of the Korea Investment Corporation, where he strengthened long-term investment strategies across public and alternative assets.

Mr. Choo holds a B.A. in Economics from Yonsei University and an M.A. in Economics from Michigan State University. He is a CFA charterholder since 2002 and earned the CFA Certificate in ESG Investing in 2022.
