- Research & Development Partnership

New findings from UNCTAD study show that **simplifying and digitalizing** international trade procedures **can reduce CO² emission**



Before digitization, KEPHIS (Kenya Plant Health Inspectorate Service) estimated **133.3KgCO² of emissions** Following digitization, the estimate drops to 24.4KgCO² of emissions 81% of reducion
